Merciful Embrace of God

The fourth Sunday of Lent is set aside for us to recall God's graciousness. This Sunday we celebrate Mother's day, and today we recall the graciousness of our mothers and we entrust them gratefully to God's blessing. Happy Mother's Day.

The Gospel reading for this Sunday (*Luke 15:11-32*), the parable of the prodigal son presents to us the return of the son and the merciful embrace of God. In the parable the younger son without waiting for his father to decide on property, asks for his share of the inheritance. Normally the property was divided only after the death of the father. Instead the younger son abandons his duties and responsibilities in the family and goes abroad to live a life of fun. His reckless lifestyle drains his fortunes and he finds himself reduced to abject poverty and misery. Once abandoned by his friends, he condescends to feed pigs, which Jews regard as unclean animals, showing the depths of degradation in which he finds himself. A life away from the divine leads people to a situation where they lose all sense of shame and decency.

This parable similarly is the story of the joy of a loving and forgiving father who celebrates the return of his prodigal son by throwing a big party in his honour, a banquet celebrating the reconciliation of the son with his father, his family, his community, and his God. The prodigal son is anyone of us who takes courage to come back to God, in faith that God will bestow his mercy and forgiveness to restore their relationship with God. The beautiful moment of the story is that while the younger son was still a long way off, his father saw him and was moved with pity. The Forgiving Father runs out to meet his son. The Father is overwhelmed with joy. The son also felt the joy of being forgiven and restored to a loving relationship with the Father. This describes perfectly the relationship God has with us. Even when we are far off, God is there waiting for us, waiting to welcome us. In Lent we have a special opportunity to celebrate the mercy of God. On Wednesday 9th April, Canon Gerard Bradley will prepare us to celebrate the Sacrament of Mercy. Let us experience this merciful embrace of God in the Sacrament of confession, and not to remain outside as the elder son in the parable, in order to share the joy of resurrection. Fr. Saju
