Journey Together

Last week on Wednesday evening, I met along with the catechists, the parents who are presenting their children for the First Holy Communion next year. I thank them for making this choice on behalf of their children in their faith journey. The parents, through signing in to the First Holy Communion preparation, have renewed their promise taken at the time of baptism of their children to fan the flame of faith in their children. The preparation provides catechesis to the children along with their friends who attend to grow in their understanding about the church and the Holy Mass. It is also an opportunity for the parents to meet with other parents who share the faith of the church, thus to grow in companionship with others in the parish.

Our parish is privileged to support these families and individuals with our prayers and accompaniment. Let us hold in prayers the children preparing for the First Holy Communion so that the first Holy Communion preparation may be an opportunity to experience the Eucharist as the source of spiritual life and the Altar is the centre of the Parish. This is achievable not only with the Catechetical inputs but by the accompaniment of the parents with their children. The faith journey of a child should be alongside his/her parents. This means that the parents will need to commit themselves to journey with their child during this period of preparation. First of all the parents should commit themselves to attend the weekend Mass regularly at the parish with their child. The regular attendance at Mass helps the chid see his/her friends as well as to relate with what was instructed in the First Holv Communion session

Secondly, parents need to create a sacred space at home if you have not one already, to pray with your child. The prayers taught in the session shall be used and this time of prayer you as a parent may set an example to your child. Finally, it is important that the child gets an opportunity to read Bible stories with you so that they become familiar with the life of Jesus. I humbly request all the parents and family to support your child in their preparation for Holy Communion.

New Lectionary to be launched in England and Wales for Advent 2024.

Thank you to all those who have already donated to the cost of the Lectionaries and to the family who have sponsored the cost of the Book of the Gospels.

The Lectionary is the book which contains the readings for Mass (Sundays and Weekdays), for Saints and Sacraments, and other occasions, such as funerals. It is the big book on the ambo in our churches and it comes in four large volumes.

The Lectionary is changing as part of the continuing process of revising liturgical translations. The changes are intended to make biblical translations more faithful to the original languages and in a text which is more proclaimable.

How much will the Lectionaries cost? The 4-volume Lectionary for the Ambo is £695. We will need a set each for both St. Joseph's and St. Swithun's Churches. The Chapel Edition is £395 for use in HTH Chapel. The Parish Mass Books are £4.95 each and will also need to be replaced. This represents an unavoidable cost for the parish.
