Twenty-Ninth Sunday Year B 20th October 2024
Readings on Page 146 of the Parish Mass Book

Our reading today from Hebrews was addressed to converts from Judaism, so Christians who would have been familiar with the sacred books in the Old Testament. And the predominant feature of the letter, and especially our reading today, is its teaching about Jesus - specifically his priesthood. And he makes clear, so there is no doubt among his readers, that Jesus is 'The High Priest', greater than the priests of the Mosaic law.

The writer, most likely of Jewish descent, echoes the theme of the universal redemption brought about by Jesus the mediator, through His sacrifice on the cross and the shedding of His blood. He also makes clear that there is nothing we can experience in our lives that has not been experienced by Jesus, who, as God, well understood the weakness of our nature. But as Man, Jesus was tempted in every way, just as we are, while also experiencing the sufferings that affect us, even though He himself was free from sin.

The writer was well aware that at that time believers faced a "storm of temptation', so he was encouraging them to remain truthful to the grace they had received through their Baptism. I think it is undeniable that we, as Christians today, similarly face a 'storm of temptation', probably worse because of the numerous communications channels that we have, something that even children have to face with the advent of social media.

Jesus' invitation is that when we face difficulties, including temptation, we need to turn to prayer, to pray for strength to resist sin. It sounds easy, but its not. Prayer can so often get relegated in a world which appears to keep us continually occupied with the things of this earth. I think that's the message this weekend. To make time for prayer. When we do so, we welcome God into our lives. We listen more attentively and importantly we share our troubles and faults with Him. Yes, this means seeking forgiveness, but it also renews and feeds our relationship with God. In doing so, we are better able to resist the 'storms of temptation', that we all face in our daily lives
