Marriage: Vocation to Holiness

You may well recall the opening lines in the Apostolic Exhortation of Pope Francis on love in the family, **The Joy** of Love which states, "the joy of love experienced in the families is also the joy of the Church". This statement first of all is an invitation to Christian families to value the gifts of marriage and the family as well as to experience the closeness of the church in their joy and challenges. From the first reading for this weekend (Genesis 2:18-24) we understand that God established the family by joining man and woman, thereby enabling them to alleviate the solitude which man felt amidst the animals and the world around him; and to become one body not only in its physical dimension, but in its voluntary self giving in love, a union of hearts and lives. Jesus, as we read in this week's Gospel, presents the original plan of God for man and woman as the indissolubility of marriage saying, 'what God has joined together, let no man put asunder" (Mark 10:2-16). This message is carried on among the early Christians as we read in Hebrews, "Let marriage be held in honour among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled" (Hebrew 13:4).

A crisis in a couple's relationship destabilizes the family and may lead to serious consequences for adults, children and society including the church. The church reminds us that the sacrament of marriage is not a social convention, an empty ritual or merely an outward sign of a commitment. It is a vocation to live the covenant of love and fidelity, 'inasmuch as it is a response to a specific call to experience conjugal love as an imperfect sign of the love between Christ and the Church'. (Ref. The Joy of Love). This analogy therefore reminds us to pray for an outpouring of God's divine love on every married couple. Similarly, the Church's pastoral care with love for the couple in irregular union provides an opportunity to journey towards celebrating this sacrament as a covenant and commitment, given for the sanctification and salvation of the spouses. This week let us pray for all couples that they may continue to witness marriage as a vocation and to inspire young people to embrace it with joy.
