Second Sunday of Advent-Prepare the way of the Lord

As we enter into the second week of Advent, the homily at Holy Masses this weekend facilitates an opportunity for us to revisit the Liturgy of the Word. The Scripture readings at the Holy Mass help us to listen to the faith experience of the Old Testament community as well as of the New Testament community respectively. Moreover Scripture readings remind us that we are joined by the people of the Old Testament and the New Testament whenever we gather to celebrate Holy Mass. As part of preparing for the Holy Mass, it is very important that we prayerfully go through the readings before we come to the church for the Mass, so that listening to the Word at Mass becomes an experience of listening to the faith sharing of the believing community who passed on their faith to the Church. Scripture readings likewise become a moment of God speaking to our heart not to our ears with God's love and compassion.

The key phrase in this weekend's Gospel for me is 'prepare the way of the Lord'. This cry is the reflection of the Hebrew prophets like Isaiah 40:3, Joel 2:12-13, as well as an invitation to return to the Lord from all ways of sin. Advent is a penitential season; a time of repentance, contrition and conversion of heart. We may from time to time become fallen, wounded and in need of healing and renewal (from Walk with me). However we may be blind to our own blindness. The Advent penitential service in our Parish on Monday 16 December from 7.30 pm to 8.30 pm will be a suitable time for us to experience God's mercy. St. Ambrose says, 'God waits for our tears that God may pour forth His goodness.' Our preparation of hearts will give meaning to our longing for the coming of the Lord at Christmas. The Advent preparation as St. Paul reminds us through the second reading will be our means of preparation for Advent, "my prayer is that your love for each other may increase more and more and never stop improving your knowledge and deepening your perception so that you can always recognise what is best. This will help you to become pure and blameless, and prepare you for the Day of Christ" (Phil 1:11). Fr Saiu
